Please read the information below carefully and ensure that you meet all entry requirements and can commit to all the rules of the pageant.

ELIGIBILITY

- Contestants must be resident in the UK
- Contestants must aged between 18 years - 26 years (ID Will be needed to verify)
- Contestants must be 5'4 or over in height
- Contestants must be of Ghanaian parentage (one or both parents)

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete application form (return by 31st May 2011)
- Attach two photographs – (a full length and a face shot)
- Write a short piece (minimum half A4 page) on **'Why you should be crowned Miss Ghana UK'**

SELECTING/JUDGING:

- All valid entries will be judged on their Appearance (overall look) and the written piece on 'Why you should be crowned Miss Ghana UK'
- Finalist will be notified by phone and will receive written confirmation
- Finalists will be invited to participate in event
- The 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners will be chosen at the grand final
- In the event that a contestant is disqualified, the organisers reserve the right to give that contestants place to the next highest placed contestant

By participating in the pageant, entrants agree to be bound by the official rules and the decisions of the judges, which are final.

PRIZES

Prizes for Winner, 1st and 2nd Runners up will be confirmed.

(Prizes are subject to change and will be confirmed to contestant selected for the finals)

Prizes will be received within 120 days of competition

PARTICIPATING AS A MISS GHANA UK CONTESTANT

- Contestants MUST submit a fully completed application form and registration fee of £25 before they will be allowed for the selection process/for the first part of the contest
- The eventual winner must have the necessary travel documentation required for travelling
- The eventual winner, 2nd and 3rd are under contract with MGUK for one year and must be available when needed for events, promotion etc when required by MGUK.
- The eventual winner 2nd and 3rd will need MGUK permission to do other promotions outside MGUK during the year
- All contestants must observe confidentiality and discretion at all times. (Your anonymity is paramount to any potential success you may have)
- Contestants must attend all rehearsals as well as any meetings pertaining to the event. NO family members or friends may attend rehearsals (A valid reason must be given if you're unable to attend rehearsals)
- Contestants must provide their own clothing and accessories
- Contestants must be prompt on the day of the event
- Contestants must be willing to aid one another.
